

African Nurseries – Storage of Vines

Proper storage ensures that vine quality is maintained from arrival until planting.

1. Temperature

Store vines at a stable temperature of **2–4°C** in a cool room or cold storage unit with **70–80%** humidity.

2. Positioning

Keep vines upright to avoid bending or deformation. Use bins or racks that prevent vines from laying flat or sagging.

3. Moisture Retention

Keep roots moist by wrapping them in moist sawdust, paper or other breathable media. Never allow roots to dry out.

4. Storage Duration

Limit storage time to the shortest practical window. For vines stored over long periods, monitor weekly for mould or dehydration.
